### **Budget Highlights**

- Major Cuts to General Fund (GF) Programs— More GF cuts to Come
  - Expect NO new funding for existing or expired programs

#### • REAP 2.0 Grants:

- Provides \$560 million of the original \$600 million allocated for the REAP 2.0 program. Three allocations.
  - \$480 million allocated by pop. to MPO's
  - \$30 million for a competitive program for non-MPO jurisdictions
  - \$30 million competitive program for infill housing production and reduced VMT projects.

#### Advanced Clean Fleets

- \$120 m (after \$143.9 m cut) for the Zero Emission Vehicle Fueling Infrastructure Grant Program.
  - Provides grant funding for ACF Implementation
- CSAC attached reporting reqs to Caltrans ACF funding

### Legislation

A few relevant Infrastructure bills

#### AB 1957 Wilson

Expands a pilot program statewide to allow all counties to use the best value contracting method.

<u>CSAC Position</u>: Support

Status: Chaptered

#### AB 1890 Patterson

Requires counties to report to DIR on PW project change orders and contractor changes.

<u>CSAC Position</u>: Neutral

Status: Active

#### AB 2182 Haney

Amongst a variety of provisions, contractors on PW projects must begin paying the new wage 10 days after the DIR issues the wage order.

CSAC Position:

Watch

Status: Active

#### AB 2192 Carillo

Increases project cost limits specified in the CUPCCA. Separates limits on negotiated Contracts & purchase orders from the force account limits.

<u>CSAC Position</u>: Watch
