<u>August 15:</u> Appropriations Suspense File August 31: Last day for bills to be passed (8/28-72-hour in-print rule) <u>House of Origin</u> Reles Committee Policy Committee(s) Appropriations (If Fiscal) Floor <u>Timeline: Jan-May</u>

2nd House

Appropriations (If Fiscal) Floor Timeline: Jun.-Aug.

> <u>Governor's Desk</u> Sign/Veto <u>Timeline: Sep.</u>

<u>September 30:</u>

Last day for the Governor to sign or veto bills passed before 9/1



Budget Highlights

- Major Cuts to General Fund (GF) Programs— More GF cuts to Come
 - For transportation, remaining GF-funded programs will have funding pressure shifts. In 2024 Budget Transportation saw \$973 m in GF reductions, \$555 m in fund shifts
 - <u>Active Transportation Program:</u>
 - Program reduced by \$400m GF. Now provides \$200m over 2 years (\$100 m/year) in GF funds. • Cycle 7 has \$169 available (\$31m used to fully fund
 - Cycle 6)
 - <u>SB 1 (RMRA) Funding</u>

• On track for slight growth (4%) compared to 23-24.

A few relevant Transportation Bills

AB 6 Friedman

Increases CARB authority over Transportation SCS

CSAC Position: Concerns

Status: DEAD

AB 2535 Bonta

Requires CTC to increase targets for TCEP funded projects to fund zero-emission freight infrastructure.

CSAC Position: Oppose

Status: DEAD

SB 768 Caballero

Requires CalSTA to study how VMT is used as a metric for measuring transportation

CSAC Position: Support

Status: Active

Prohibits local govts imposing a land dedication req. on housing developments to widen a roadway to mitigate traffic impacts





CSAC Position: Watch

Status: Active
