> 2nd House **Rules** Committee Policy Committee(s) Appropriations (If Fiscal) Floor Timeline: Jun.-Aug.

> > Governor's Desk Sign/Veto Timeline: Sep.

Key: Point in Time

Every Bill:

1st House

Originates in a House. Asm. (AB) or Sen. (SB) □ Then Policy Committee(s) □ If Fiscal, Appropriations Voted on House Floor


2nd House

Process Repeats

Governor's Desk □ Finally, Governor's Desk □ 1 month to act (Sign/Veto)

2024 Legislation Update

Public Works

• AB 1957 (Wilson) Best Value Contracting

- Allow all counties to use the best value contracting method.
- **CSAC** Position: Support
- **STATUS: Chaptered**

• AB 1890 (Patterson) Public works: prevailing wage

- County's approving public works contract would need to report to DIR within 30 day if:
 - A change of contractor or sub-contractor
 - Change orders in excess of \$10,000
- **CSAC Position: Oppose Unless Amended Status: Vetoed**


AB 2182 (Haney) Public Works

Amongst a variety of provisions, would have required contractors on public works projects to begin paying the new wage to laborers 10 days after the DIR issues the wage order.

CSAC Position: None

Status: Vetoed





2024 Legislation Update

Development Fees


- SB 937 (Wiener) Development projects: fees and charges.
 - Makes substantial changes to county ability to collect development fees
- CSAC Position: Oppose Unless Amended
- **Status: Chaptered**
- AB 1820 (Schiavo) Counties must provide estimate on request
- Requires counties to provide estimate of development fee to project proponent.
 CSAC Position: Neutral
- Status: Chaptered

Advanced Clean Fleets

- AB 173: Budget Trailer Bill: Signed
- AB 2266: Held in Asm Transportation

AB 637: Vetoed

- AB 3179: Vetoed
- SB 1387: Held in Asm. Transportation
- SB 1393: Held in Sen. Environmental Quality

2024-25 Budget

Reap 2.0 Grants

Provides \$560 million of the original \$600 million (\$40 million cut)
for the REAP 2.0 program.

ZEV Fueling Infrastructure Grant Program (Advanced Clean Fleets)

- o 2024 Budget reduces program by \$143.9 million
- Leaves the program with \$119.5 million to provide grant funding

AB 173: Caltrans ACF reporting

 Caltrans to publicly report on a variety of data points related to their purchase of ACF vehicles
